#### **Where To Meet**

#### **What to Expect**

Upon arrival, you will spend the afternoon getting to know the horse that you have been assigned to for your stay. You will also get to know the wranglers that will be working with you.



Each morning starts with a good breakfast, a devotional and then it is off to greet our trusty mounts. You will learn how to act safely around your horse, proper care and grooming, why a horse thinks and acts the way they do, learn to speak 'horse language', become a confident rider, play games with your horse and so much more. All of these skills are practiced in the controlled and secure environment of a covered arena before we ever hit the trails.

Once you have honed your riding skills we will pack our lunches and hit the trail for day long rides. You will get lots of horse time as you learn to take care of your horse at the ranch and on the trail.

Each evening you will have personal time with your horse before we sit down, sing songs and share life around the campfire.

Participants should expect to be challenged mentally, physically and spiritually as they participate in this exciting program.
